Keep Your Pets Safe People Foods Toxic to Pets



Every pet parent has experienced it---you're enjoying a good meal or one of your favorite snacks, then you look down and see your furbaby staring longingly at what you are eating. You want to give your furry friend a treat too—after all, they are part of your family and your buddy. As much as you want to share your food with your dog or cat, many human foods can be highly toxic for your pet. Some of the more hazardous edible items include:

- Alcoholic drinks and food products containing alcohol
- Avocado
- Caffeine (found in a lot of drinks such as coffee, tea, soda, and energy drinks)

- Garlic
- Grapes and raisins
- Macadamia nuts
- Marijuana
- Medicine intended for people or another pet, unless directed by your veterinarian (for example, nonsteroidal anti-inflammatory drugs for people, such as aspirin, ibuprofen, and naproxen, may not be right for your pet and may even be harmful; and the common pain reliever acetaminophen is fatal to cats)
- Onions
- Salt
- <u>Tobacco products</u> (including e-cigarettes and their refills)
- **Xylitol** (a sweetener found in products such as some sugar-free chewing gum, sugar-free candy, cough syrup, mouthwash, and toothpaste)
- Yeast products (like raw bread dough)

The Bow Wow Luau & The Cat's Meow® has donated over \$70,000.00 to reduce shelter euthansia. Our Pet Food Bank prevents owner surrenders and has donated over 134,155 LBS. of pet food. We created a unique coalition of local governmental agencies and human charitable organizations to provide pet food to the most food insecure. We expanded our Pet Food Bank and Pet Meals On Wheels Chapters in Onslow, Pender and Brunswick Counties. WoofStock, adopts at-risk dogs and cats. Our Disaster Relief Programs filled three tractor trailers with pet food to hurricane-impacted areas from Hurricanes Maria; Florence and Dorian. We sent two crates of pet food to help Hurricane Ian pet victims. We sent five pallets of pet food to war-torn Ukraine. We are committed to saving the lives of homeless dogs and cats and will not stop until all dogs and cats have good homes!
