This summer I had the honor and privilege to meet two of my personal heroes---Julie Castle, CEO of Best Friends Animal Society, and Silva Battista, one of the co-founders of Best Friends Animal Society. Best Friends has been such an inspiration to me and my animal advocacy since I discovered them in 2005. Best Friends Animal Society is the largest no-kill animal sanctuary in the world and some of their lifesaving work includes saving animals impacted by Hurricane Katrina; rehabilitation of dogs from the horrendous Michael Vick fighting rings and now leading a national movement to end the killing of companion animals.

Their magazines contain fun and whimsical stories of hope about animals at their sanctuary. I have the complete collection of Best Friends magazines since I began receiving them in 2005. In 2011, Best Friends magazines were much of the inspiration when I created the fun theme and whimsical name for our annual fundraiser, "*The Bow Wow Luau & The Cat's Meow*(®", that has raised and donated over \$70,000.00 to save homeless dogs and cats.

In 2014, I traveled to Kanab, Utah to volunteer at Best Friends animal sanctuary, which is a healing home to over 1,600 previously abandoned and abused animals. I thoroughly enjoyed working with the animals there. I was honored to be invited to lunch with two of the co-founders, Silva

Saving Lives of Homeless Dogs and Cats and Feeding Hungry Pets

Like many of us, Best Friends believes that every pet has a story and each one is worth saving. I started supporting their lifesaving work in 2005 and continue doing so. In 2017, I was listed in Best Friends Annual Impact Report (three spaces below Jennifer Anniston!). I am honored to be on the North Carolina Steering Committee for Best Friends, as well as being a Best Friends Network partner. I have participated in their National Conferences in Las Vegas, Los Angeles, and most recently, in Raleigh. I am honored that I was invited to the VIP reception for all three, where I have met most all the Best Friends co-founders and their CEO, Julie Castle. Best Friends has created a national movement to end the killing of our animal friends in shelters and to achieve nokill nationwide by 2025.

Tragically, North Carolina ranks #3 in the nation of euthanasia due to pet overpopulation. These innocent creatures cannot speak or act on their own behalf. The animals desperately need our help!!

Best Friends Animal Society has been much of the inspiration of my animal advocacy and has helped reveal my life's calling—saving homeless animals! That inspiration has led to starting my animal advocacy nonprofit, Heidi's Hope for Homeless Animals, Inc., that has raised and donated over \$70,000 to local rescue groups, spay/neuter programs, and our shelter. It has also led to three communitywide pet donation drives that sent three tractor trailers of pet food and supplies to help hurricane-impacted areas from Hurricanes Irma, Florence, and Dorian. Heidi's Hope for Homeless Animals' Pet Food Bank has created a unique coalition of partnerships including many local county governmental offices and key human charitable organizations that distribute pet food monthly to the most vulnerable in our community. Our Pet Food Bank has donated over 135,155 lbs. of pet food and supplies and we are enthusiastic that we are adding additional chapters of Heidi's Hope for Homeless Animals' Pet Food Banks in North Carolina! We have already expanded our Pet Food Bank Chapters to Onslow, Brunswick, and Pender counties! Stay tuned.... Heidi's Hope Pet Food Bank has some extremely exciting news on additional services that we will be providing to continue to keep pets out of shelters and stay home with their families where they belong!

Meeting two of my personal heroes was a dream come true. Silva Battista and Julie Castle are the true Jane Goodall's of our day---devoted animal heroes! Best Friends co-founders have overcome tremendous obstacles, where a small group of people made a leap of faith to realize a vision that they had long shared — to create a sanctuary for

Bastilla and Gabriel de Peyer. Afterwards, Silva gave me a tour and we discussed the incredible journey of the Best Friends' beginnings to the national movement it is today. The story of Best Friends is an inspiring story of the power of a belief! *(continued)*
